

Throughout, the book emphasizes fundamental clinical principles that enable the clinician to think through clinical decisions moment-to-moment and also to develop an overall sense of the trajectory and goals of treatment. Taking a diagnosis-driven approach, the book describes goals, strategies, tactics, and techniques, demonstrating the flexibility of the approach across a relatively long course of treatment. Finally, the authors provide a sophisticated discussion of integrating dynamic psychotherapy with medication management and other forms of treatment.

As an educator who has spent 30 years working with trainees learning to do psychotherapy, and learning to apply complex models of the mind to clinical work of all kinds, I found this book to be a perfect guide. Dr. Caligor has done an amazing job of explaining how therapy works based on our

Also, the systematic approach to evaluating patients and discussing diagnosis and treatment options is extremely helpful, as is the adaptability of this treatment for use with medication and other psychotherapies.
