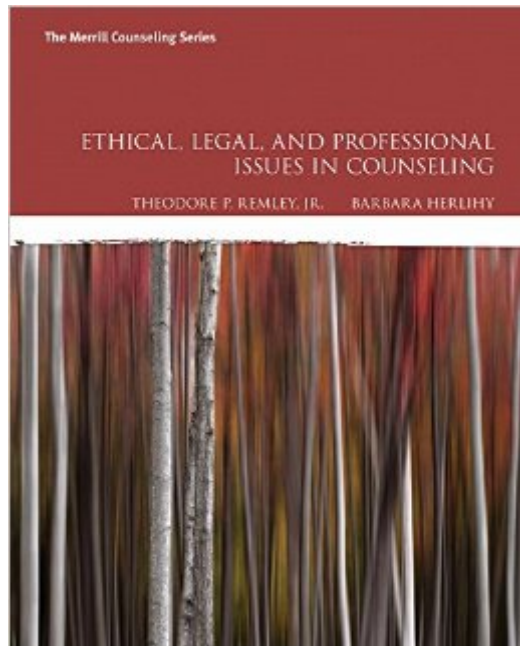


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Ethical, Legal, And Professional Issues In Counseling (5th Edition)
